RESPONSIBILITIES

Assistance with Production

- Accurately weighs materials for the batches to the specific formulations.
- Examines and restocks the different materials used in the batch weighing process.
- Timely locates, distributes, and transacts (IQMS) materials to avoid any production interruption.
- Assists with accurately operating the line when processing batches.
- Accurately weighs out product and places batches into the correct areas.
- Operates machines and assists with transferring the product onto the proper conveyors.
- Inspects products for size, color, and visual appearance.
- Utilizes special tools available to aid in moving materials safely from one process to the other.
- Cleans and maintains work area and equipment and assists in maintaining organization throughout the foaming area.
- Assists with skiving as needed.
- Documents machine process information in the run file.
- Operates machines to satisfy orders.
- Actively assists in maintaining production goals and ISO expectations.
- Safely operates the forklift to various work and storage areas in the delivery and storage of materials, packaging, and finished goods.
- Offers suggestions for productivity improvement and work flow processes.
- May be cross trained or assigned other subassemblies duties as needed.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Values and culture fit
- High School diploma or GED preferred; and 3-6 months related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience
- Ability to read and comprehend simple instructions, short correspondence, and memos.
- Ability to write simple correspondence.
- Ability to effectively present information in one-on-one and small group situations to customers, clients, and other employees of the organization.
- Ability to add, subtract, multiply, and divide in all units of measure, using whole numbers, common fractions, and decimals.
- Ability to compute rate, ratio, and percent and to draw and interpret bar graphs.
- Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out detailed but uninvolved written or oral instructions.



- Ability to deal with problems involving a few concrete variables in standardized situations.

- A successful completion and valid license is required for Forklift Driver Certification.
- Must be self motivated and possess the ability to make decisions.
- Must be able to professionally handle stressful situations and demonstrate teamwork.
